PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
REGISTER OF ECONOMIC ANALYSTS

**Art. 1**  
**(Purpose)**

The Parliamentary Budget Office hereby publishes a notice for the establishment of a register of economic analysts in the following sectors:

- a) revenues;
- b) pensions, welfare and labour market;
- c) health, education, justice, defence and the environment;
- d) local government finance;
- e) quantitative modelling;
- f) investment, research and development and competitiveness;
- g) debt, banking system and financial markets.

The register will be used to grant professional engagements, pursuant to Article 14 of the Rules governing the placement and compensation of the staff of the Parliamentary Budget Office.

**Art. 2**  
**(Presentation of candidates)**

Persons interested in being entered in the register should submit their application via e-mail to [segreteria@upbilancio.it](mailto:segreteria@upbilancio.it), attaching their curriculum vitae and an electronic copy of a valid identification document.

**Art. 3**  
**(Publication and updating of the register)**

The register of economic analysts of the Parliamentary Budget Office is prepared and published on the website in alphabetical order. It is not a ranking, and entry in the register does not constitute a commitment on the part of the PBO to grant any professional engagement.

The register will be updated and republished periodically with the inclusion of new enrolees.

Each professional engagement will be granted with a resolution of the Board of the PBO.

The unit responsible for the procedure is the Office of the Director General of the PBO. The person responsible for the procedure is the Director General.

**Art. 4**  
**(Processing of personal data)**

Pursuant to Art. 13 of Legislative Decree 196 of 30 June 2003 concerning the protection of personal data, any information provided by the candidates is collected by the Parliamentary Budget Office for the purpose of managing the procedure. That data may also be processed with automated systems.

The data provided may only be disseminated to other government departments for the purpose of verifying the declarations of the candidates or in the other cases provided for under laws or regulations.

The persons affected have the rights referred to in Art. 7 of the above legislative decree, including the right to access the data that concerns them, and a number of associated rights, including the right to correct, update, complete or remove erroneous or incomplete data or data collected in an illegal manner. They also have the right to oppose the processing of such data for legitimate cause.

These rights may be exercised with respect to the Parliamentary Budget Office, via del Seminario 76, 00186, Rome, the data controller. The data processor is the Director General.
